INTRODUCTION

Food contact materials play a critical role in protecting consumer's health and safety. Various packaging materials need to be investigated according to their intended uses for potential risk associated with direct or indirect food contact. Since new packaging materials and additives are being invented and used, research and investigation techniques on food contact materials must be updated and capable of detecting those potential risks at a very low scale level. Research on food contact materials must become an inevitably part of those who dealing with inventing, fabricating, converting and applying of all packaging materials. We should not rely only on routine testing, but well-planned research is needed to fully understand complex mechanism of food contact material systems in order to provide safe solutions for consumers and general public. Prevention of incidents form unsafe food contact materials can be sustainably prevented by innovative research and experiment.

This forum opens opportunity for packaging researchers, packaging engineers, packaging R&D and packaging industry as well to discuss with internationally recognized experts from difference countries. All experts and researchers have extensive experience on food packaging and food contact materials. Some of the speakers are also supported by the EU delegation.

The meeting is also in conjunction with Asian Packaging Network (APN) general meeting 2015. This event is a general meeting of researchers in packaging and materials technology area from Asian countries to meet and share their packaging research experience. 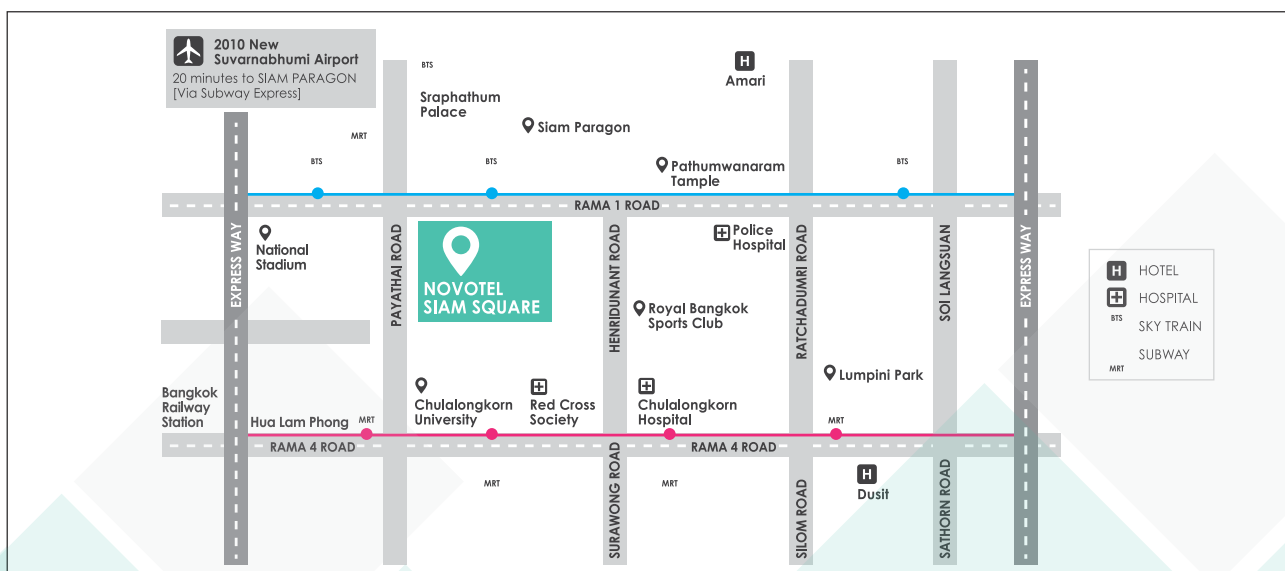
